MINUTES

At the regular monthly meeting held on Monday December 7 at 7:30 P. M. the following were present: Mayor G. M. Perry, Chief W. A. Gaines, councilmembers: J. W. Wallace, Jr., G. T. Newton, Doyle Elrod, Grady Berry, C. F. James.

The first discussion was on the License Ordinance. Last years ordinance's were given out. The Mayor asked if there were any changes to be made. There was none and J. W. Wallace made a motion that we pass this ordinance and use the same as last year. C. F. James 2nd the motion. It was unanimous.

The audit report from Mr. Whitmire was given out to the Council for them to study over.

Christmas lights were discussed and the resolution that the Council made last year they wished to keep and t at was to pay \$50.00 of the light bill for the lights. The bill last year was \$38.10. Doyle Elrod made a motion that the town do the same this year, C. F. James 2nd the motion. There was no discussion and it was passed.

Mr. Perry then asked the council about liability ins. on our volunteer Fire Department. The town would be liable if these boys should get hurt. The figures on this insurance on our department would be \$60.00 and then medical and hospital \$35.00 making a total of \$95.00 if all of these coverages are wanted. G. T. Newton made a motion that we buy this insurance, all of it. J. W. Wallace 2nd the motion. It was unanimous.

The next subject brought before the council was the Bond issue election. The Commissioners of Election had a meeting to verify this election as under the law. The Council will have to do this do. J. W. Wallace made motion that this resolution be passed. C. F. James 2nd. There was no discussion and all signed this resolution.

Mr. Gaines said that the Church of God Parsonage wanted to connect on to our sewerage, they live out of town so we will not get any taxes on this. G. T. Newton said that we should let them connect on. C. F. James 2nd this motion. It was unanimous.

The meeting then adjourned.
