The Town Council held its regular meeting December 7, 1959. The minutes were read and approved after which Mayor Carson read a letter of resignation from Mr. Gaines as peace officer, effective December, 30, 1959. Mr. Gaines made a proposition to Council about the garbage pick up. Mr. Gaines said that he would take the job at \$75.00 per week. Mr. Bolding made a motion that Mr. Gaines be hired at the rate of \$75.00 per week. Mr. Bryan 2nd the motion. His duties are to check disposal plants twice a week, sweep the streets at least twice a week, pick up trash at homes one time per week. and ~~xxxxxxx~~ ~~xxxxxxx~~ as much as needed in town. Also patch up work that is needed on streets and etc.

Mayor Carson read a letter from Cornel Stevens in regards to the Maw Bridge ~~xxxxx~~ He also read a letter concerning a stop light in Central. This was discussed, but no action was taken.


It was mentioned that more street lights were needed in residential sections. This included McAlisters Alley, the street by Tom Reams & Cecil Bice, near Heyward Brooks, at the end of Georgia St., and another big light at the school house. and in Head Town. The councilmen agreed to check on these.

The matter of getting a Christmas bonus was brought up. No decision was made, but the council agreed that something would be worked out this spring in order to have a vacation with pay.

The Council agreed to pay additional cost on insurance for the police car.

A special meeting was called for the purpose of action on setting license fees. Mr. holding made a motion that any outside of town person selling furniture, appliances, clothing, or notions from truck or car, pay a license fee of \$50.00. Mr. Dyar 2nd. the motion, the council voted unanously.

A discussion was held on other rates, action on these are as follows: Any person erecting Tomb Stones the license fee will be \$20.00 a year, or \$5.00 per day. Any gas Company selling bottled gas will pay a fee of \$25.00 per year. All oyt of town Plumbing & heating Companies a fee of \$50.00. Outside of town Laundries the fee to be \$50.00. Printing and office supplæes fee \$10.00.


