

Regular Council Meeting
December 10, 1990 7:00 P. M.

Call to order: Mayor Alton B. Cumbie, III.

Invocation: Harry Holladay

Minutes of the November 12, 1990 meeting were read. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Stan Thompson to accept after corrections. Vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Public Safety - no old business

Frank Chaka - Financial report and Christmas Bonus - Gave favorable report.

Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Stan Thompson to give Christmas bonus same as year before. Vote unanimous .

Lou Robinson - Planning - Mr. Steve Pelissier was recognized. He presented the proposed zoning map and book. Public hearing needed before council adopts. Meeting can be held January 14, 1991 and have first reading immediately after hearing. Motion by Lou Robinson, second by "Doc" Evatt to hold meeting January 14, 1990 at 6:30 P. M. Mr. Pelissier to be here for the hearing and was thanked by Mayor and Council for his efforts in preparing the zoning information.

Clarence Phillips - Water and Sewer - no old business

Harry Holladay - Recreation - none

"Doc" Evatt - Streets and Sanitation - none

NEW BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Public Safety - Noted that a letter needed to be written to Chairman of County Council concerning Rural Fire Protection. Ask for their alternatives if Central should stop this service. Need reply by work session February 4, 1991. Noted that Jessamine and Lawton Roads were paved by the county but the town had no input.

Frank Chaka - Gaston & Gaston, Auditors were presented. Doug Gaston presented the enterprise fund and Bruce the general fund. Both gave a favorable report for the FYE September 30, 1990.

Lou Robinson: Steve Pelissier had presented information on zoning map and book. No other report.

Clarence Phillips - 18 Mile Creek report. Waiting for report on feasibility of upgrade or new plan for the 18 Mile Creek Project.

Harry Holladay - Discussion of purchasing new uniforms for basketball teams. Need to get sponsors so names can be put on uniforms. A cost of \$330-400 per team. Discussion only. Mayor Cumbie to discuss this with Mr. Busha. Do not ask for donations at this time.

"Doc" Evatt - Recycle and trash pickup. Containers discussed with different alternatives. Need Tom Hendricks input before action. To ask Mr. Hendricks to be here for next work session. Mayor Cumbie noted that we³¹⁴to decide on how to fund the project, such as add fees, taxes or other source.

Administrator's report:

- 1- Talked with Highway Department about soil erosion on Gaines Street. For present to dump dirt and town will fill erosion areas.
- 2- Highway 88 Water District: Report on line. Town to keep our line for additional water resource. Highway 88 to get water from Norris end of line. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by "Doc" Evatt to go ahead and repair line. Vote was unanimous.


It was noted that some of the timbers in the old school had rotted out. Librarian upset and county building inspector advised that it needed to be replaced.
