MINUTES REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING DEC. 13, 1976

Those Present: Councilmen Hopkins, Busha, Porter, Thompson. Mayor Holladay, Town Administrator John Bethea, Town Attorney Mr. Bill Acker, Roy Collins representing the school trustee's, Chief of Police Harold Duncan, Clerk-Treas. Catherine Hughes.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting to order and the minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

Mayor asked councilman Porter to give a report on the Community Park Building that had been repaired. Porter stated that the roof had been replaced and chimney had been repaired the approx. cost was \$2,200.00 & completed.

A report was given concerning the Christmas Parade which was Dec. 9, 1976 that involved approximately \$500.00 that was approved earlier by the council.

Motion by Busha, 2nd by Hopkins on the 2nd and final reading of the Business License Ordinance for the year 1977. Motion passed.

Meeting with the council was Roy Collins representing the school board trustee's concerning the Old School House (Elementary), The Town of Central & the Clemson Little Theatre. Discussion was made concerning the 15 year Contract agreement between the Town and the School board with the Clemson Little Theatre. Copies of these agreements are attached to these minutes. According to the Town's attorney, (Bill Acker), stated that the contract seem complete with the exception of other parts of the school building may be used by the community. No action was taken on the above agreements.

Mayor Holladay asked councilman Porter to work with Roy Collins on the approximate cost involving the Town portion to repair what would be needed for the Old Elementary School Building and report at the next council meeting.

Motion by Busha, 2nd by Hopkins to give regular employee's a weeks pay for Christmas Bonus. Motion passed.

Recomendation by Porter if it was okay with chief to hire Mr. Clifton T. Cartee as partime policeman. Chief stated that this recomendation was fine with him. Motion by Hopkins, 2nd by Porter if Mr. Cartee accepts this ~~XXXXXX~~ position he be paid \$3.50 per hour. Motion passed.

Motion by Hopkins, 2nd by Porter to hire Mr. Clifton T. Cartee, Sr. as partime animal control officer and pay \$5.00 per hour with Mr. Cartee furnishing transportation and the Town buy feed and build a dog lot at the south treatment plant. Motion passed.

Bethea stated the the Policy & Manual job description for employee's were being placed in the mail from COG.


Hopkins brought before the council the matter of persons that were not on the sewerage system which were approximately 12 persons. No action was taken.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.


