## COUNCIL MEETING

Those Present: Mayor Holladay, Fowler, Thompson Kennemore, Cumbie, O'Dell.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Holladay the matter in discussion was brought up of permits required by the zoning ordinance, also meeting with the council was John Hamilton to receive permission to add a room to his house.

Motion was made by Cumbie, 2nd by Fowler that a fee for a building permit be \$10.00 first \$10,000, \$1.00 per thousand above, also that the fee collected be given to the building inspector (Mr. Wade Cambelli.)

Cumbie brought before the council the matter of the 2nd Wesleyan Church parsonage sewerage connection. Motion made by Thompson 2nd by O'Dell if the Church annexed into the city that they be given a free tap, if not pay the regular fee. Motion carried.

Mayor stated the finances of the town should be in good standing by Jan. 1, 1974.

Discussion of Hwg. 88 by John Head was brought before the council as whether the town was due the reconnection fee of \$5.00 from Hwg. 88. Council checked the contract made with 88 and the reconnection fee is due to the Town of Central.

Discussion was made on the depot that had been moved to the equipment lot of underpinning, but no action taken.

O'Dell brought before the council the matter of doing a water tap for Lorette Gossett's brother and billing the Government Administration for the tap. Council asked that Lorette bring a letter to the town office stating the facts, then procedure could be done.

The History Book Yesterday & Today written by Mrs. Allen is selling good, as of this date \$775.00 has been sold.

Motion by Cumbie, 2nd by Thompson to refund Troy Smith who purchased a Business License and didn't obtain any business. Motion carried.

Motion by Fowler, 2nd by Cumbie to mark of total bad debt of \$19.99, providing if customer move back into town all back debts, be cleared before water is turned back on. Motion carried.
