

Regular Council Meeting
December 9, 1991 7:00 P. M.

Present: Mayor Alton B. Cumbie, III; Council: Frank Chaka, Harry Holladay; "Doc" Evatt; Clarence Phillips; Stan Thompson; Lou Robinson; Herbert Thompson, Administrator; Troy Porter, Savannah ^{City} ~~Charters~~; Willie Gaines, Mary Gaines, Michael Fellin and friend; Doyle, Dean and Lex Burton.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by "Doc" Evatt.

Minutes of the November 11, 1991 meeting were presented. Motion by Frank Chaka, seconded by Stan Thompson to approve with one correction. Vote was unanimous.

PUBLIC SESSION: Troy Porter was recognized. He made a request that the 25 ball players, 18 cheerleaders and some parents be hosted at a banquet to show appreciation for their winning the Upstate Championship in football. This being the 11 and 12 year olds. He presented this as input for the Recreation Department and left it up to council to decide. No action taken.

Willie Gaines requested that the bad curve on Spring Forest Drive have some markings as it has become a dangerous situation due to speeding vehicles. Mr. Herb Thompson to check into this matter.

Savannah Anderson inquired on grant. Mayor Cumbie informed her that a workshop was in the making and no official word had been received on the grant.

REGULAR SESSION:

OLD BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Public Safety - None

Frank Chaka - Financial Report - Mr. Chaka reported that budget is in black so far.

Lou Robinson - Planning - No new news on S. C. Downtown Development Association.

Clarence Phillips - Water and Sewer - No report.

Harry Holladay - Recreation - No report.

"Doc" Evatt - Streets and Sanitation. Mr. Evatt inquired as to status of road off James Circle to S. C. Housing. Herb Thompson reported that he is awaiting word from the county as to what they will do. Property has been deeded to town by Mr. & Ms. Melvin Brooks.

Old School was discussed. Discussion only.

NEW BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - None

Frank Chaka - None

Lou Robinson - Inquired as to worker for CDBG grant. This person to be from COG.

Ms. Robinson inquired as to tenure of Planning Commission members. It was noted that these terms are staggered.

Clarence Phillips - None

Harry Holladay - Mr. Holladay suggested that in lieu of a banquet as suggested by Mr. Troy Porter a light jacket would be more appropriate. He presented this in the form of a motion, the motion died for lack of a second. Mr. Holladay and Mr. Herb Thompson to come up with proposal for council.

"Doc" Evatt - Mr. Evatt made a request that a proclamation be made for Six Mile, Clemson and Central for Daniel High School Football team since they are the state champions. In the past the mayors have presented the proclamation.

Administrator's Report:

A proposal for green box fees was presented. This an informal proposal and to be discussed at next work session.

Mr. Herb Thompson reported that the audit report for F.Y.E. September 30, 1991 ended in the black.

Doyle Burton presented some drawings for possibility of annexing a section of his property into the town. Discussion only. Mr. Herb Thompson noted that if in the future this should transpire he would be in favor only of running water to a master meter on Hwy 18 and a pit to be used to house the meter.

Mr. Thompson stated that the 2 roads to be paved by the state would be Wesleyan Drive and Brock Street. Also, the drawings for the pressure valve for Hwy #18 is in

hand.
Mayor's Report:

Mayor Cumbie presented a resolution to create a Task Force to review duplication of services. A committee was established. Harry Holladay to serve and "Doc" Evatt to serve as alternate. After reading the resolution, motion by Frank Chaka, second by Stan Thompson to accept the resolution. Vote was unanimous. It was noted that Mayor Cumbie and Councilwoman Lou Robinson attended the Palmetto Leadership Conference.

Mayor Cumbie read a resolution to appoint John Head as Fire Chief. Motion by Stan Thompson, second by Frank Chaka to accept the resolution. After discussion of resolution in lieu of fire department members electing their own chief, council voted unanimously in favor of the resolution.

Mayor Cumbie gave second reading on ordinance to annex the property of Clyde T. Bryant into the Town of Central. Motion by Clarence Phillips, second by Lou Robinson to accept. Vote was unanimous.

Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Lou Robinson to go into executive session for discussion of Christmas bonuses. Vote was unanimous.


Clerk/Treasurer

Council adjourned the executive session. Mayor Cumbie recalled regular session for the purpose of voting on an employee Christmas bonus. Motion by Frank Chaka that we adopt the following employee Christmas Bonus Policy for December 1991:

0 thru 1 year	= \$25.00
1 year & 1 day thru 3 years	= 50.00
3 years & 1 day thru 5 years	= 100.00
5 years & 1 day thru 10 years	= 150.00
10 years & 1 day	= 200.00

Part-time employees will receive 1/2 the pay of a full time employee. The Christmas Bonue Policy is for December 1991 and Council will reveiw this policy each year before any Christmas bonus will be approved. Stan Thompson seconded this motion. Motion carried.
