Regular Council Meeting
March 13, 1979
MINUTES

The Regular Council Meeting of March 13, 1979 was held with the following present: Hopkins, Porter, Chaka, Thompson, Boyles, Evatt Mayor Holladay, Clerk Treas. Catherine Hughes. News Media representative from the Messenger & Pickens Sentinel.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting of March 13, 1979 to order and the reading of the last Regular Council Meeting Feb. 12, 1979 were read and approved as read.

Mayor Holladay present the Financial Report for the month of Feb. to the council and noted that the Town was 42% of the budget for our fiscal year. This included Oct. 1, 1978 through Feb. 1979. (5 months.) Council accepted without any question.

Mayor Holladay presented the Police Report for the month of Feb. to council and stated the Chief was back work on full time basis and seemed to be doing okay.

Mayor Holladay presented the Administrator Report to the Council for the previous month. Copies were present to each Council.

Departmental Policy (Police Dept.) Motion by Chaka to adopt the Police Dept. Policy with correction made to the rough draft. The motion was seconded by Hopkins. Council passed without opposition.

Water Dept. Policy: Motion by Thompson seconded by Boyles to adopt the Water Dept. Policy previously presented to council. Council passed without opposition.

Proclamation of Beautification: Motion by Thompson to adopt the Proclamation of Beautification April 1--April 7, 1979 and designate the same dates as future Week of Beautification. Motion seconded by Hopkins. Council passed without opposition.

Mayor Holladay suggest that a committee be appointed for the Central Wesleyan College, Cannon Mills, Rratt Read Co., also that church bulletins receive this information, that a memo be mailed to each business in town. Garbage Bags will be furnished for different group or organizations in the clean up week.

Finacial Plan was discussed but no action taken at this time. Thompson stated he would be working with Administrator on this matter.

New Business: Motion by Thompson seconded by Hopkins to submit bids on the maintenance for Mt. Zion Cemetery for the summer of 1979. Motion passed without opposition. Bids are to be in by April 1, 1979.

Motion by Porter seconded by Hopkins that no gate fees be charged during the softball season. Council passed without opposition.
