

Town Council Meeting
June 11, 1979

The meeting was called to order at 7: P. M. All Council persons were present.

Mr. Jones read the previous minutes in the absence of the Town Clerk, due to illness. Minutes were approved as read.

The Finance report then was studied - no questions, it was adopted.

The Second reading on the Ordinance that required vacant lots to be kept clean. It was moved and seconded that the ordinance be approved with the last paragraph changed to read:, that billing would be from the Town Office rather than handled through the County Treasurer's Office.

Second reading was held on adoption of certain Codes prepared by the Southern Building Codes Congress International, Inc. It moved and seconded that the codes be adopted.

Second reading was held on annexation of the Ms. Evalia Wilson property on Harper Street. Motion was to accept , it was seconded and passed. *

No action was taken on request of Mrs. Nellie Hayes relative to coping in the Mt. Zion Cemetery. Council desired that a copy of present ordinance be copies and mailed to each one for study.

Council recognized the drainage problem in front of the Brock Apartments, however due to the cost of replacing or altering the present drain problem, it was suggested that we flush out with the fire hose.

Received Police Report from Chief Besser.

Mack Crane was recognized for a report on the planned Hill Billy Day on August 11, 1979. It appears that everything was progressing according to their schedule. He then requested that the Hill Billy Day be made an annual affair so they could plan ahead and schedule speakers and entertainers. A motion was made by Porter and seconded by Hopkins that the Hill Billy Day be an annual affair. Motion passes.

Discussion was held relative to the parking problem that might be presented at the 16th of June homecoming for the Central High School Graduates. Chief Besser was to work this out.

No new business to come before the Council, the Council went into executive session to discuss the annual evaluation of Lt. Smith of the Police Dpt. After review of the evaluation it was moved to advance Lt. Smith one step in grade 5 which would be to Step 5.

Mr. Lee Chastain request was presented to Council relative to tapping a mobile home off of his present water line paying minimum fee for said home or even metering from his line. After some discussion Council was in agreement that a separate tap and line would need to be run as per our present policy.

No further business to come before council the meeting adjourned.
