

Council was informed that the water study by the Town Engineers, Rogers and Callcott was not complete but should be by regular meeting in August.

Council gave Mr. Jones authority to make application with BOR on resurfacing tennis and basketball courts located at Central Park, on a 50 to 50 basis. This would be a grant.

Motion was made by Thompson, seconded by Porter to go into executive session to discuss personnel evaluation. Motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Jones, the Town Administrator was then excused. Council voted to raise Mr. Jones in Grade 9 from step 3 to step 5, effective 6/27/79.
