## REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING -----MINUTES

The meeting of August 13, 1979 was opened at 7 p.m. with the following present: Councilmen Porter, Thompson, Hopkins, Boyles and Chaka. Mayor Holladay, Clerk & Treasurer Hughes, Town Administrator Barney D. Jones. News media representatives from the Messenger and Pickens Sentinel.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting to order and the minutes of the last council meeting were read and approved as read.

Financial report was presented to council. Mr. Jones stated that the financial matter needed to be looked into. Suggested that a meeting be set with the mayor and finance committee.

Mr. Jones stated that S. C. Housing Authority money was approved and they were ready to start on project as soon as site was located.

Mr. Jones stated that Seigle was complete with sewer line at Cedar Creek and that engineers had given punch sheet for completion. Water line is complete and test was taken today for state approval.

Mr. Jones stated that the Senior Citizen Project at old Elementary School is under way.


There being no further business the regular meeting adjourned at
