At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council held on Monday night January 7, 1952 at 7:30 P. M. the following were present: G. M. Perry, Mayor, W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police and Councilmembers; S. C. Carson, J. W. Wallace and C. F. James.

The meeting was called to order and the first subject discussed was street surfacing that the County did for the town. All the private work that was done has been paid for except Cliff McAlister and the Central Business Men's Association. The Town funds are nearly exhausted and these bills must be paid because they were paid to the County and Campbell Limestone out of Town funds.

Street Lights were then discussed the council talked on this for some time and it was agreed to put three light on the upper end of town. One at the corner of C. C. Phillips and wherever they are needed most. S. C. Carson and J. W. Wallace were elected to look over this area and put the light in the places that they are needed most.

The meeting was then adjourned.
