Administrator's report--Popular Springs Church damage from sewer. Town not responsible for damage. Letter to this effect to be sent.


Noted new police vehicle was ready to be picked up this week.

Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to go into executive session to discuss financial matter. Mr. Chaka withdrew his motion and regular session resumes for discussion of budget.
