Mayor Cumbie went over the future outlook of the Federal Revenue Sharing program as given by the government.

Dr. Busha presented his request for \$2,000. Mayor Cumbie assured him that as long as P.C.C.O.A. had a center in Central the Town would make the building (2 rooms) available to P.C.C.O.A. and that \$2,000 would also be available. That if Dr. Busha would present to the Town what each center cost, the Town would consider its allotment.

After much discussion the Mayor restated that the Town of Central would make available to P. C.C.O.A. \$2,000.

Mrs. Roberts from Friends of Daniel made a request for \$500. Mayor Cumbie stated that he would take this request to council.
