

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

June 4, 1987

Present: Mayor Alton Cumbie, Councilmen Clarence Phillips, Harry Holladay, "Doc" Evatt, Henry Law, Frank Chaka, Troy Porter; Terry Creager, The Greenville News; Lynn Warnock, The Messenger; Attorney Pickens Lindsay; Mr. Orville White.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Motion by Mr. Law, second by Mr. Chaka to go into executive session for discussion of letter from Mayor Abernathy, the City of Clemson.

Letter was presented and after discussion, comments to the fact that we must keep our commitment to the Hardees property, the Merck family and others wishing to annex into the Town of Central.

Motion by Harry Holladay, second by Troy Porter to reject the letter. Vote was unanimous.

Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Porter to resume regular session.

Mayor announced to the press that it was unanimous that council reject the letter, stating that our commitment to Hardees, Martin and Claypool must be kept, that the people wanted to be annexed to Central and must pursue second reading. Desire good working relationships with Clemson and ready to proceed with business.

After discussion Motion by Mr. Phillips, second by Mr. Holladay, to withdraw motion made in executive session to reject the letter. Vote unanimous.

In public session motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Law to to reject the letter. Vote was unanimous.

Petitions were presented for 17 parcels, signed by owners. This would allow for annexation of five parcels not signed.

Motion by Mr. Law second by Mr. Phillips to accept this annexation on FIRST READING. Vote unanimous. Time 11:58 A. M.

Motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Chaka to accept on SECOND READING the annexation request of May 29, 1987. This time 11:36 A. M.
