October 14, 1968

A Special Call Meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, October 14, 1968, at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor, L. S. Griffin, Councilmen C. B. Bryan, W. W. Norwood, Herbert Thompson, Jr., A. R. Cureton, J. R. Herd, and George Fowler.

Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting.

The question pertaining to back taxes prior to 1968 was discussed, and Councilman Cureton made a motion that the necessary steps be taken, legal or otherwise, to collect all taxes past due. This motion was seconded by Councilman Fowler, and was unanimously adopted.

Councilman Bryan made a motion that the new fire truck not be carried out of the city limits, except when being approved first by the Mayor or Mayor Protem. If neither of the above could be contacted, then any Councilman could give permission to carry firetruck outside of city limits. This motion was seconded by Councilman Herd, and was unanimously adopted.

Chief A. C. Arnold was present at the meeting, and a discussion was held, led by Councilman Cureton, pertaining to problems of the traffic and other violations in Town. After the lengthy discussion of pro and con, Chief Arnold agreed that he would make some special efforts on these problems that were discussed. Also Chief Arnold was asked to be present at the next regular Council Meeting, and make a report of his results.

The question pertaining to the United Fund Contribution was discussed, but no disposition was made. Mayor Griffin was asked to check with other Towns and see if they made a contribution to this cause, or etc.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
