Called Council Meeting  
7: P. M. April 24, 1979

Council met at 7: P. M. with all members present. The Town Administrator read the minutes of the last meeting. Minutes approved as read.

Mr. Mack Crane presented a request to hold their Annual Hill-Billy Day, on August 11th. He outlined the extent of expected participation, and invited guest which includes the Governor, Senator Thurmond and Dorn among them. He asked the Mayor to introduce the guest. Council approved the request.

The Town Administrator was asked to give second reading on the annexation of the Cumbie Property which includes a petition from the Medical Center and Mr. & Mrs. Boyles. Councilman Thompson moved acceptance of ordinance, seconded by Councilman Chaka, motion passed without dissent.

The Engineering firm of Rogers & Callcott presented a need to study our water system and identify possible problems. They suggested that after a report they be allowed to write request for a grant/loan to carry out their recommendations. Expected cost for such a study through grant stage \$3500.00. Several questions were asked and the Mayor appointed a committee of Councilmen Hopkins, Porter and Administrator Jones to bring back recommendations to the next council meeting.

Mr. Jones Presented the bidding on Bid # 4-79 for water pipe and fittings for the Cedar Creek and White Oak Circle Projects. Davis Supply was the low bidder on entire list of items, Council left the awarding to the administrator.

Financing of the pipe and need for cash to anticipation of expected income was discussed. Councilman Porter moved the borrowing of \$50,000.00. Councilman Hopkins seconded. Motion passed without opposition.

Mr. Jones briefed the Council on letter received from Mr. W. O. Brown's lawyer relative to refusal to issue Mr. Brown a business license. A check will be made relative to compliance with the agreement Mr. Brown made with the Town before next meeting.

Mr. Jones read a "Thank You" card from Mrs. Dorothy Sims.

Council asked Mr. Jones to request the police to take action on a car parked on Aiken Street for over a year. Also patrolling Madden Bridge Road early morning (especially school hours) and afternoon when school is out. Council has received numerous complaints on this.

No further business to come before Council, the meeting was adjourned.
