Those present: Councilman Chaka, Hopkins, Evatt, Mayor Holladay, Clerk & Treas. Catherine Hughes, Mr. William Hall, news media representative from Pickens Sentinel.

A letter of appreciation from the Central Shriners was read to the Council for Hillbilly Day.

Invitation was read to Council for the Kick Off Meeting to be held Monday Oct. 1, 1979 7 p.m. for the United Way, at LeJuans.

Mr. William Hall from the Council of Governments was present to hold the second hearing for a preapplication grant to be submitted to HUD Oct. 1, 1979 for the Town of Central. This application was on Community Development.

Motion made by Chaka to approve a $\frac{1}{4}$ page ad for the Daniel Schools. Motion was seconded by Hopkins. Council approved without descent.

Motion by Hopkins seconded by Evatt to charge the town's cost for leaf bags inside .12 outside .15 each. Council passed without opposition.
