Special Call Meeting
October 4, 1993
6:30 P.M. Central Town Hall, 105 Werner St.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Mayor Cumbie then entertained for a motion to go into Executive Session to receive legal briefing from Attorney Roy Bates on the Revised Business License Ordinance. Motion was made by Frank Chaka, second by Clarence Phillips. Vote was unanimous.

Attorney Roy Bates & G. C. Robinett with Governmental Consultants, Inc. gave a briefing on the legal status of a proposed revision of the Town of Central's Business License Ordinance created by Government Consultants Inc. After briefing, Council members discussed the different aspects of the revised Business License Ordinance with Attorney Roy Bates & Mr. G.C. Robinett. Mayor Cumbie then called for adjournment of the executive session with no action taken. Motion made by Frank Chaka second by Calvin "Doc" Evatt. Vote was unanimous.

Mayor Cumbie then entertained for a motion to go back into the Special Called Council Meeting. Motion was made by Frank Chaka second by Clarence Phillips. Vote was unanimous.

At this time Council Conference Room was open. Present: Gay Lawson.

Mayor Cumbie entertained for a motion on first reading of Ordinance #93-1110BL to amend Business License Ordinance rate for Life, Health & Accident Insurance whereas to be consistent with State Law. Motion made by Lou Robinson, second by Frank Chaka. Vote was unanimous.

Mayor Cumbie entertained for a motion on Resolution No: 93-11-10DEBT; the Setoff Debt Collection of 1988 (Section 12-54-410) which allows the S. C. Tax Commission to render assistance in the collection of debt owing to a political subdivision. Motion made by Clarence Phillips second by Harry Holladay to adopt this Resolution. Vote was unanimous.

There being no further business the special called meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M. Motion by Stanley Thompson second by Calvin "Doc" Evatt. Vote was unanimous.
