Special Town Council Meeting

January 22, 1973

Those Present: Messrs: O'Dell, Fowler, Thompson, Hopkins
Holladay and Mrs. Williams.

The Mayor called the special meeting of the Council to discuss placing the water billing on the computer system. After discussing the miscellaneous things that could happen on a given billing, the motion was made by Mr. Hopkins to proceed with the computer system; seconded by Mr. Fowler.

The council then discussed the cut-off date on the water bills. It was stated that these bills are being carried up until the end of the month. It was recommended that we stick to the notice on the bill allowing one week before cutting the water off. THOSE BILLS NOT PAID BY THE 15th of THE MONTH WILL BE CUT OFF WITHOUT NOTICE. Mrs. Williams stated that she would send out a letter in this month's bills advising the customers of the cut-off date. The council made the motion (O'Dell) that this practice be accepted, it was seconded by Mr. Fowler.

Mr. Thompson then gave the council the price on the 4-wheel truck the Town wishes to purchase. \$3,622.46. The motion was made by Mr. Hopkins to proceed with the purchase of the truck, seconded by Mr. Fowler.

The council asked the Mayor if the papers had been submitted for the Police Communications Funding. The Mayor asked to be reminded to speak to Chief Duncan about this.

With no further matters to bring up, the Council adjourned.
