CALL MEETING OF TOWN COUNCIL

1. The ordinance concerning Telephone Occupational License Tax was adopted on a motion by O'Dell and second by Fowler.

2a. There was discussion about the traffic problem at the Central Elementary School as the result of the children arriving prior to daylight. Lights are needed at the school crossing. A motion was made by Kennemore, seconded by Hopkins, to get Duke Power to install two (2) street lights at the crossing on Church Street. (b) The Police Committee, motion by Kennemore and second by Hopkins, moved to keep the third-shift policeman on duty extra time (1/2 hour) to help with the school crossing.

3. John Head informed the council that Tim Rowland has applied for a job with the Town. A motion was made by Fowler that he be hired on a probationary basis; the motion was seconded by Hopkins. The motion passed with one opposing vote by Kennemore. Mr. Rowland will be notified of his hiring and be explained his responsibilities. His starting salary will be \$125.00.
