A Special Call Meeting of the Town Council was held on Friday, March 27, 1970 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor L. S. Griffin, Councilmen J. R. Herd, W. W. Norwood, George Fowler, and Herbert Thompson, Jr. Also present for the meeting was Mr. Chisman.

The purpose of the meeting was to meet with Mr. Chisman pertaining to his request for a water line being built to his development and property on the Maw Bridge Road. After considerable discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Thompson, that the following resolution be adopted.

That Mr. Chisman would be permitted to build a 2" plastic water line, according to standard plumbing regulations, the line to be of the same grade of plastic now being used by the Easley-Central Water District for their lines, and is to be purchased through the Easley-Central Water District. When said line is completed, it will be deeded back to the Town of Central by Mr. Chisman. Further, if the plans now being negotiated with Clarence Merck is suitable that the line hook on with his line, beginning there, otherwise, Mr. Chisman would build the 2" line to Ramseur Street and hook on at the end of the 6" Water Line. And further, if any damage to the now existing water lines be done, they would be repaired by the said Mr. Chisman, no expense to the Town of Central, or to the person who may own the Water Line in that area.

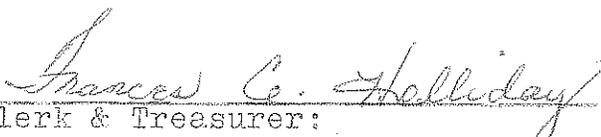
Further, if and when this line is completed and deeded back to the Town of Central, the Town of Central will supply water at the out-of-Town-Water Rates, with the Out-of-Town Tap-On-Fees and that a maximum number of 20 Tap-On's will be allowed on this 2" Line; all taps are restricted to the Chisman Development and none allowed elsewhere. This resolution was unanimously approved by the Councilmen present.

By unanimous consent it was agreed not to purchase the Computyper Billing Machine now being left here for demonstration, and that the Company be notified to pick the machine up at their convenience.

No other business was transacted at this Meeting.
