Special Called Meeting 7 P. M. April 1, 1980

Mayor Holladay called the Council to order, all members were present, and stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss a letter received from the East Clemson Water District.

Council studied the letter contents and discussed it in relationship to the overall plans to upgrade the distribution system of which East Clemson Water District is a part. Several alternate plans were discussed which would have the effect of eliminating the East Clemson Water District from the project, since they stated in the letter they had no known pressure problem. The Council looked at the current rate structure in light of the utilities present deficit operation. From the discussion the administrator was directed to:


1. Write East Clemson Water District that since they were experiencing no problems and had alternate source, of water, we would not consider them in our plans.
2. Contact our Engineer relative to the possibility of upgrading only parts of our system to increase pressure in certain areas without building a new tank or main lines.
3. Present an ordinance ~~ordinance~~ to amendment budget ordinance which would raise water rates on household meter to a minimum of \$4.00 for 3,000 gallons and \$1.00 per M over the minimum, leaving sewer surcharge at 50% of the water bill. Outside rates would be set at \$5.00 for 3,000 gallons and \$1.00 per M over the minimum with 100% sewer surcharge at the next regular Council Meeting.

Mr. Jones mentioned that a warrant had been issued to Mr. W. O. Brown for non-compliance with Section 4-201 of the Town Code. The Mayor stated that Mr. Brown had approached him with the proposition that if the Town would give him two (2) years he would move outside of town limits. No action was taken.

Councilman Porter brought up the possibility of purchasing a leaf vacuum. Mayor asked that it be put on the April Regular Meeting Agenda.
