



April 2, 1984 Special Called Meeting

Present: Mayor Summey, Councilmen Frank Chaka, Troy Porter, Dan Evatt, Olin Gambrell, Chief Cantrell, Thad Garrick, Henry Law, David Boyles, Harry Bailey, Sue Seaborn of the Monitor, Grace Towe.

The Mayor opened with prayer.

A-James Spearman Building: Motion by Troy Porter, second by Frank Chaka to accept Planning Commissions approval to build 25 additional units and provide 41 parking spaces off street. Dan Evatt asked for an amendment to Mr. Porter's motion to accept provided water and sewer taps are paid. This died for lack of second. Mr. Porter called for question-Vote 2-1 Dan Evatt objected. Mayor opposed saying time to get funds to upgrade sewer plant. Mr. Porter asked for Spearman issue to be put on next meeting agenda because of tie vote.

Patterson Estates addition: Motion by Mr. Porter, second by Dan Evatt to accept Planning Commission's approval for 7 additional houses, waiving water and sewer taps. ~~Vote unanimous.~~ *3-1 Mayor opposed same reason as opposing Mr. Spearman's request*
Dan Phillips situation: Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka to get legal opinion and act at next Monday's regular council meeting. Vote unan.

Mt. Zion Cemetery: Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Troy Porter to have attorney reference back to 1971 and bring back to next meeting.

Roads to be fixed by state: Priority No. 1 Gaines Street to Johnson Road
Road 18 around Mill Pond to Pepper Street

Priority No. 2 Pratt Read Road, Wernor Street and Bank Street.
Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka to accept these priorities.
Vote unanimous
