Special Called Meeting

Present: Mayor Summey, Councilmen Troy Porter, Frank Chaka, Dan Evatt, Olin Gambrell, Administrator, Chief Frank Cantrell, Ronnie Barnett, Messenger, Grace Towe, Clerk "Doc" Evatt away in Texas on job.

Invocation by Mayor Summey

Clerk swore in newly elected councilman Henry Law and he was seated.
SECOND READING ON AMENDMENT TO BUDGET. Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka, vote unanimous

Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Dan Evatt to declare the ordinance on coin operated service void. Vote *UNANIM.*

Request from Mayor:

- I. Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka to open session at 6:30-7:00 P. M. for input of citizens, prior to regular council meetings. Vote unanimous.
- II. Mayor presented Fire Chief John Head's request to raffle off 1970 Ford for proceeds to upgrade Van donated by Duckett Funeral Home. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Dan Evatt to accept. Vote unanimous.
- III. Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka to put water tap in triangle for Garden Club, this being a prior commitment from Revenue Sharing. Vote unanimous.

BUDGET:

- I. Dan Evatt presented list of views on items that would reflect in a workable budget.
- II. Troy Porter's view was to see what 1 mill would equal, increase budget to reflect this, along with cost of living raise for employees and live within budget. 18 mill increase should take care of expenses.
- III. Frank Chaka said to freeze salaries for 1 year, cut police car and pick-up from budget, increase tax millage 5, put impact fee on future developments, put in general fund, keep spending to bare minimum, cut inventory.
- IV. Henry Law--cut fat from budget, break even and pay bank what is owed, 18 mills won't pull out of hold.
- V. Mayor's proposal--freeze some, cut some, raise some budget items.

Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka to look into C & S Trust Department as custodian for funds stated in bond ordinance.

Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Henry Law to accept his proposal (copy attached, items 1,3,&6. Mr. Porter called for question. Mayor polled council:

Dan Evatt, yes Henry Law, yes Troy Porter, No Frank Chaka, No. Mayor voted no. Mr. Law asked to be excused. Motion by Troy Porter, Second by Frank Chaka for FIRST READING ON BUDGET WITH AMENDMENTS Vote 3-1 Mayor voted no.

Discussion of water rates: Motion by Troy Porter, second by Frank Chaka to have first reading an ordinance to RAISE WATER AND SEWER FEES AND FIRST READING ON ORDINANCE TO RAISE TAX MILLAGE 10 mils. Vote 3-1 Mayor stated should raise millage higher and leave water and sewer rates alone.

Dan Evatt asked to go on record saying if mayor could come up with a better proposal than had been presented he would go along with it.

Troy porter reiterated.

Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Dan Evatt to adjourn.
