A Special Call Meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, April 28, 1969 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor, L. S. Griffin, Councilmen George Fowler, C. B. Bryan, W. W. Norwood, J. R. Herd, Herbert Thompson, Jr., and A. R. Cureton.

Mayor L. S. Griffin presided over the meeting.

This Special Meeting was called for the purpose of discussing matters pertaining to the new building and other business that was pending.

The first matter of business discussed was pertaining to trailers and trailer courts within the city limits. Councilman Norwood made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fowler, that any person locating a trailer or trailer court within the city limits, get permission from the property owners adjoining the space that such trailer or trailer court is to be located, and secure a permit from the Town Office and that the permit for a Trailer Court be \$500.00, & anything being over one trailer to be considered a trailer court.

Councilman Cureton made a motion, seconded by Councilman Thompson, that the Sewerage Tap-On Fee be raised from \$50.00 per unit to \$125.00 per unit, except in the case of trailers, which would be \$175.00 per unit.

Councilman Cureton made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fowler, that the Water Tap-On Fee be raised from \$75.00 per unit, to \$100.00 per unit in Town Limits, and from \$100.00 per unit to \$175.00 per unit outside Town Limits.

A motion was made by Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Thompson, that the Mayor talk with Tommy Teat and see if he would drop the idea of a trailer court and etc.

A motion was made by Councilman Herd, seconded by Councilman Thompson, that we use the terrazzo floor in the New Town Hall. A color was selected and this vote was unanimously carried.

It was also unanimously agreed that a water cooler be installed in the Town Hall near the door entrance to the Fire Station.

There was no further business transacted at this Meeting. Meeting adjourned.
