Special Council Meeting

Minutes

A petition was presented from a majority of the Town Council requesting that a special meeting be held. (Sec. 2-210 Central Code).

Motion made by Mr. Gambrell, second by Mr. Rampey that the meeting come to order. Vote unanimous.

(Mr. Chaka was unable to attend because of erroneous information concerning the date of the meeting.)

In the absence of the Mayor (and Mayor Pro Tem), Mr. Porter made a motion, seconded by Mr. Rampey that Mr. Gambrell serve as Chairman of the meeting. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Gambrell took the chair.

The only item of business was the 2nd reading of the ordinance setting utility rates.

Mr. Porter made the motion that the ordinance be adopted on Second Reading.

Mr. Rampey seconded the motion. (He did note that he was opposed to the fact that the increase brought in more income than was needed to fund the tank. All other councilmen agreed with those sentiments.)

Administrator noted that these rates were contained in the Letter of Conditions from Farmers Home. There being no further discussion, the Chair called for a vote.
