A Special Call Meeting of the Town Council was held on Friday, June 4, 1971 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor, H. R. Holladay, Councilmen, A. B. Cumbie, Jr., Glen D. O'Dell, Jack Kennemore, J. R. Herd, George Fowler, and Herbert Thompson, Jr. Also present for the meeting were the following Trustees from the Central Business Association: Mr. T. A. Folger, Mr. J. Leland Brock, Mr. S. C. Carson. Town Attorney, W. G. Acker was also present.

The purpose of this Special Call Meeting was to discuss a Title To Real Estate being granted to the Town of Central by the Central Business Association. After much discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Cumbie to accept the Deed to the City Park as written and to increase the tax millage by 10 (ten) mills. This motion was seconded by Councilman O'Dell. The millage increase is for the up-keep of facilities, if all not needed in a particular year it may be used for other recreational purposes, but the primary use will be for maintenance of Community recreation facilities. This vote was carried unanimously.

A letter of request/to come into the city limits was read. Said request consisted of a lot of land running approximately 330 feet along Kennemore Street to the center of Meredith Street, and 106 feet to the land of J. Lawton Brock. Councilman Thompson made a motion seconded by Councilman Cumbie to grant this request. This vote was unanimous.

Sewer *
A motion was made by Councilman Cumbie, seconded by Councilman Fowler, that one sewer tap be made for each individual house, trailer or duplex unit. Any other apartment, motel, or hotel exceeding a duplex unit would be ruled on individually. This Ordinance supercedes all previous Ordinances. This vote was unanimous. Also this motion was to apply to the request for annexation from J. Lawton Brock, previously granted. X

A report was made from the Fire Dept. Committee in that they had not been able to locate a fire truck suitable to be used for the Rural Fire Residents. After some discussion, a motion was made by Councilman O'Dell, seconded by Councilman Kennemore, to buy a new tank, truck and pump to haul water to rural fires. This equipment to be paid for by the income from rural fire protection fees. This vote was unanimous.

A motion was made by Councilman Cumbie, seconded by Councilman Fowler, to paint the City Hall Meeting Room. This vote was unanimous.
