All Council members were present with the exception of Mr Furman Hopkins and Mrs Phylis Boyles.


The Mayor called the meeting to order.

The Town Administrator read the proposed Contract Extension, which was as follows:


That the present Water Contract with Highway Eighty-Eight Water Company, Incorporated, dated September 14, 1972, be extended for another two (2) years beginning September 14, 1972 at the current rate of 0.45 per thousand gallons of water. However, due to the inflationary pressures being experienced, the Town of Central reserves the right to modify the referenced contract in the same amount per thousand that its supplier applies to the Town of Central. If such occurs prior to the completion of this two (2) year extension period.

Councilman Chaka moved the extension of the Contract, and Mr Thompson seconded the motion. The motion then was adopted without dissent.

No further business to come before the Council, the meeting adjourned.
