

August 1, 1983
Called Council Meeting

Present: Mayor Summey, Mr. Chaka, Mr. D. Byatt, Mr. Gambrell,
Mr. Porter - *Mr. C. Evatt absent - Family sickness*
Also present: Administrator; City Engineer Vernon Atkinson
In addition: L. Garrett-Messenger; S. Seaborn-Monitor

- A. Mayor called the meeting to order.
- B. The Mayor called the public hearing on amending the 1982-83 Revenue Sharing Budget to order. (No one was present to comment).
- C. The Administrator presented a letter from the city engineer recommending that the bid on the water tank be awarded to Na-con Services, Inc.
Motion by Mr. Gambrell; second by Mr. Chaka to accept this recommendation.
Vote was unanimous in favor.
The Mayor adjourned the special meeting.
- D. (8:00) The Mayor called the public hearing on use of 1983-84 Revenue Sharing funds to order.
Mr. Buddy Madden of the Central Rescue Squad requested that any funds that might come in over the anticipated \$45,000 (up to 1,800) be given to the Central Rescue Squad to purchase 6 pocket-pagers.
Mr. D. Evatt suggested that if enough money came in that the Central Garden Club be granted \$500.00.
The Council stated that it appreciated the input and that these requests would be given every consideration.

The Council then resumed the work session portion of the meeting. No official action was taken on any other matter. The Administrator was instructed to purchase 54 water meters immediately.
