- A. Appointment of Deborah Cromer to serve as Acting Clerk-Treasurer-Motion by Mr. Gambrell; second by Mr. Sims/Chaka to approve. Vote unanimous.
- B. Mr. Floyd read the letter of conditions and discussed various aspects with Town officials. Mr. Floyd presented a resolution. Motion by Mr. Chaka; second by Mr. Gambrell to approve. Vote unanimous.
- C. Administrator presented a change in the garbage route.
- D. Request from Mr. Reid for the right to purchase water. A letter was presented by Mr. Reid that gave him the right to tap on at a future date (see copy). City Attorney stated that he considered the letter to be a valid promise of water service. An agreement was proposed-see copy. Motion by Mr. Gambrell; second by Mr. Sims to adopt. Vote unanimous.
- E. Acceptance of Newton Lift stations. A letter was presented from Mr. Robert Newton requesting that the Town accept operation and maintenance responsibilities on the lift stations that will serve the Hamilton Place Sub-division. (See letter.) There was discussion concerning the age of the upper station. Motion to accept the lift stations as per the letter; by Mr. Porter; second by Mr. Sims. Vote 6-1. The Mayor opposed the acceptance on the grounds that the upper lift station was not acceptable. Motion carried.
