A Special Call Meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, August 19, 1968, at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor L. S. Griffin, Councilmen W. W. Norwood, C. B. Bryan, A. R. Cureton, G. H. Werner, W. A. Parsons, <sup>and</sup> J. R. Herd, ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~  
Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting.

The purpose of this meeting was to further consider the allowing of a street dance to be held in the Town of Central by the CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE.

Councilman Norwood made a motion that we rescind the action taken at a previous meeting, and that we allow the Centennial group to have the street dance, so long as it was sponsored by the Centennial Committee. Councilman Cureton seconded the motion. After brief discussion, the Council voted five in favor of the motion and one opposing it, Councilman Herd casting the opposing vote.

A letter from Mr. Otis Coggins was presented to the Council regarding the mud and snow tires for the new fire truck. The letter stated that the tires would cost \$68.00 in addition to the previous prices quoted on the fire truck. Councilman Norwood made a motion that we have the mud and snow tread tires come on the truck and pay the additional \$68.00. Councilman Herd seconded the motion. The vote was carried.

The question came before the Council regarding the spraying for mosquito in Town. After some discussion it was decided that if this could be done at a reasonable cost, to purchase whatever needed and have John Head to proceed with the spraying.

It was suggested that the Mayor and Town Clerk proceed with the proper publications and announcements for the coming Town Election to be held on September 24, 1968.

Being no futher business, the meeting adjourned.
