September 19, 1983

Final Reading-1983-84 Budgets

Motion by Mr. Chaka; second by Mr. Gambrell to approve.
Vote 5-1; Dan Evatt opposed because he believes that the
Town is one FW employee heavy.

2nd Reading-Municipal Association Ordinance setting license
Fees for unlicensed out-of-state fire and casualty companies
Motion by Doc Evatt; 2nd Mr. Chaka to approve. Vote unani-
mous.

1st Reading-Ordinance annexing site of water tank. Motion
by Mr. Dan Evatt; second by Mr. Gambrell to approve. Vote
unanimous.

Discussion on raising water/sewer tap fees. Motion by Mr.
Calvin Evatt to table for further discussion. 2nd by
Mr. Chaka. Vote unanimous.

Discussion from residents of Heatherwood/East Briar area
reference annexation. Residents stated that they did not
intend to pose a burden to the other residents of Central.

Mr. Porter stated that the residents of Heatherwood/East
Briar needed to be aware of the Town's concern over who
was to pay the cost of trunk line and lift station that
would eventually serve the area. He also stated that he
felt that the Town should serve the area's water needs.

Councilman Dan Evatt proposed that the Planning Commission
and the Board of Adjustments be enlarged; the Town be
divided into zones (geographic) that would enable the
residents of the Heatherwood/East Briar area to receive
representation on those commissions. Mr. E. L. Bolick,
Chairman of the Planning Commission stated that he had
no objections to that proposal.

Mr. Dan Evatt made the following motion: The Administrator
and the Mayor be empowered to investigate the lagoon situation
make a recommendation to the Council of a contract that
would cover the various points addressed in the initial
letter from the residents of these areas. These would
then be mailed to the Council for study and presented
to the area residents at the October 3rd Work Session.
2nd by Mr. Chaka. Vote unanimous.
