

MINUTES
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING 5:30 P. M.
September 24, 1980

The Council was called to order by Mayor Holladay with all Councilpersons present.

Mayor Holladay briefed Council on the hearing by the Highway Department at Edwards Jr. High School on the 23rd. He then presented a drafted letter for each member to sign if they were in agreement. Copy attached.

The Administrator requested direction from Council as to the changing of the application made to SRC and Farmers Home Administration as results of the water study. The Governor's office said all grants had to be matched by the Town dollar for dollar. Therefore, the project as submitted needed to be redone, by September 30th. Previously our application was on an 80/20 basis. Another factor has come up with the Fire Districting in the County. Because of Fire Insurance rating a tank would be more desirable at this time. Mr. Jones recommended proceeding with a tank plus the 8" line to the school. After discussion by Council, Mr. Hopkins moved that the project be revamped by our Engineering firm as suggested by Mr. Jones, Mr. Chaka seconded the motion. This would up the total amount of the project to \$350,000. A loan would be required for \$150,000 from the Farmers Home Association. The Council approved without a dissenting vote.

Mr. Jones requested a name for a street in the Zion Circle subdivision. It was consensus of opinion that the street be named Hamilton Street.

No further business to come before Council the meeting was adjourned.
