

Called Council Meeting  
Sept. 30, 1980

Those present: Councilmen Calvin Evatt, Herbert Thompson, Frank Chaka, Troy Porter & Councilperson Phyllis Boyles, Mayor H.R. Holladay, Admin. Barney Jones, Clerk & Treas. Catherine Hughes, Carl Rampey, Olin Gambrell III, James G. Evatt Jr, John P. Summey, Rev. Jack Hester, News Media from the Messenger and other citizens of the Town.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting to order and minutes of the last Council meetings Sept. 8, 1980 & Sept. 24, 1980 were read and approved as read.

The purpose of this meeting was to final actions that had transpired by the present Council & swearing in new officers for the Council & Mayor 's seat.

Motion was made by Thompson to adopt second reading on an Ordinance of Fraud Checks. Motion was seconded by Chaka and carried by entire council.

Rev. Jack Hester, pastor of Cannon Memorial Baptist Church then led in prayer asking divine guidance & leadership on the new council that had been sworn into office.

John P. Summey then filled the seat as mayor and thanked the people & asked for their continued support. Mayor Summey recommended the following councilmen to serve on department committee's: They are Planning & Development, Troy Porter, Recreation Calvin Evatt, Water & Sewer Frank Chaka, Public Safety Carl Rampey, St. & San. James G. Evatt Jr. & Finance Olin Gambrell III. Motion was made by Chaka to accept the Mayor's recommendations for the above committee's. Motion was seconded by Rampey and approved by Council.

Motion by Chaka seconded by Porter to adopt 1st reading on hiring a Ministerial Recorder for the Town of Central. Council approved without opposition. Recommendation by Porter for the Mayor & Admin. to present at the regular council meeting a name of someone to fill this position.

Council then elected Frank Chaka as Mayor Protem.
