

Special Called Meeting
September 30, 1987

SECOND AND FINAL reading on budget for 1987-88 fiscal year. After discussion and noting that water rates are based on no summer sewer policy, and no maximum on sewer, motion was made by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Law to adopt on final reading. Vote unanimous.

SECOND READING on Recreation budget. Motion by Mr. Law to hire new recreation director. Died for lack of second. Motion by Mr. Porter, second by Mr. Chaka to adopt recreation budget on final reading. Vote unanimous.
