## CALLED MEETING OCT. 2, 1978 MINUTES COUNCIL

Those present: Mayor Holladay, Troy Porter, Calvin (Doc) Evatt, Frank Chaka, Thompson, Boyles & Hopkins. New Media Marth Navy (Messefger).

The meeting of Oct. 2, 1978 was called to order by Mayor H. R. Holladay and the following were sworn into office by Town Clerk. Troy Porter to serve a term of 4 years. Term expires Sept. 1982 (127) votes. Calvin E. Doc Evatt serves a term of 4 years. Term expires Sept. 1982 (126) votes. Frank Chaka serving a term of 2 years. Term expires Sept. 1980. (115) votes. Filling the unexpired set of Michael Shields whose term expires Sept. 1980. *Council 10/2/78*

Mayor Holladay briefed the new council on the Council form of Government and appointed council members to different committee's. They are as follows: 1) Chief of Police Committee--Frank Chaka, 2) St. Dept. Committee Calvin E. Doc Evatt, 3) Planning & Development Troy Porter, 4) Fire Dept. Committee Herbert Thompson, 5) Water & Sewer Dept. Committee Furman Hopkins Sr., Recreation Committee Phyllis Boyles & Finance Committee Herbert Thompson Jr.

Motion by Hopkins to elect Herbert Thompson Jr. as Mayor Pro tem. The motion was seconded by Chaka and voted by council unanimously. This term will expire Sept. 1980.

Motion by Hopkins, seconded by Boyles to establish a Grievance Committee to consist of three persons. It shall be chaired by the Councilperson assigned to that Department. Then the Mayor will appoint one other councilperson, and a Department Supervisor to hear the grievance with the Chairman. In the event there is an appeal over the ruling of the E. C. O. C. Committee, then the entire Council must hear the grievance. Council voted unanimously. *See Attached*

Appointment of Job Evaluation Committee, Pay Scale and Table of Organaziation. Motion by Hopkins seconded by Chaka to appoint a pay scale committee. Mayor Holladay appointed Herbert Thompson and Frank Chaka to this Committee.

Motion by Evatt and seconded by Hopkins to appoint Rev. Jerry Scott as chairman for the Christmas Parade to be held the week of Dec. 4th. Motion adopted by unanimously vote of council.

Motion by Thompson seconded by Hopkins to adopt the 2nd reading of an ordinance to borrow money to the remainder of the year 1978. Council approved.

Motion by Hopkins seconded by Thompson to sell property known as
