Called Council Meeting Minutes  
Oct. 30, 1978

Those Present: Chaka, Thompson, Boyles, Evatt, Porter, Hopkins, mayor Holladay. Administrator Barney D. Jones, Clerk Treas. Hughes.

Motion by Chaka seconded by Evatt to accept the bid from Church of God in the amount of \$250.00 for the property known as the Old Water Filter Plant. Motion carried. Only (1) bid submitted.

Motion by Thompson seconded by Chaka to pay the physical fees for the policeman that will be attending the Academy. Council approved.

Request for water and sewer to the lot adjoining lot #15 in Spring Forest owned by Langston (Jimmy) and located on the outside of city limits. Plans for this lot is a 6 unit apt. Motion by Thompson seconded by Hopkins to grant request on the same base as was granted to Bob Newton and Alfred Lehmann which consist of a letter of request to come inside the town. \$625.00 per unit. if additional units are built. This is for water and sewer per unit. Landscaping etc. Motion Carried.

Discussion of the Pine Knoll Court lots nos: 15 & 11 were discussed. According to Mr. Campbell (Building Inspector) lot 15 was okay. Lot # 11 was in question. After checking the zoning of lot 11 and talking with Mr. Jimmy Langston lot 11 was okay. Langston plans were to build 4 separate buildings. Council stated that permits would have to be for separate buildings and water & sewer taps for each building.

Motion by Thomspson seconded by Evatt to reject the (1) bid received from Bailey Breazeale of Easley ~~XXXXXX~~ for water and sewer lines installed at White Oak Circle in the of \$12,895. Council voted to reject.

According to Mr. Jones the permit to install these lines would expire Nov. 1, 1978. Council stated to get in touch with Joe Martin & Bobby Seigle. If necessary for the town crew to break ground in order to obtain permit.

Discussion on a bill from Harris Sporting Goods in the amt. of \$283.00 for a gun authorized by John Bethea in place of uniform allowance for Kenneth Gilstrap was discussed. After discussion council agrees to pay bill since it was authorized by the former administrator.

Council asked Mr. Jones and Police Committee Chairman of the Police Dept. to work up a policy on clothing for the Police Dept.

Motion by Porter 2nd by Thompson to accept Mr. Jones recommendation to move Mecal Stewart from St<sup>S</sup> & Wtr. to Wtr. Dept. ~~with~~ A salary increase to \$10,000 a year. Motion by Thompson 2nd by Evatt to increase. Council approved.

Recommendation form Administrator to appoint local committee to help share the problems with the Recreation Dept. Mayor Holladay suggest that Chairman of the Rec. Dept. (Phyllis Boyles) along with Recreation Director and Administrator work out a policy for the Recreation Dept.

Mr. Jones read a letter of request from Mr. Eugene Vickery for water & sewer lines to his property located down hwy. 93. No action was taken. See letter.

Council suggest that Mr. Jones draw up an ordinance pertaining to Personnel & Equipment for Priviate Use. Check with Attorney General and get a ruling.

Administrator was asked by council to draw up the ordinance and mail a copy to them prior to the next regular meeting.

There being no further business the meeting of OCT. 30, 1978 adjourned at 8:20 p.m., and Executive Session was called.
