

Special Called Meeting
November 7, 1988

Invocation by Mr. Holladay.

Discussion of the after-school program. It was noted that the program was a no go at this time and might be considered again this summer. Need to study more. Table till later.

Copy of service agreement attached. This Ordinance No. 12-204-8 to Provide for a Lease and Service Contract and an Agreement to Sell the Water System of the District. After discussion motion by Clarence Phillips, second by Troy Porter, to accept with the stipulation that we sign lease and service contract, pay Clemson up front 8% of total settlement and retain 8% of Robert Bowen's services. Also, to accept the certificate authorizing Mayor Cumbie and Clerk Grace Towe to sign lease. After discussion the vote was unanimous to accept on first reading.

Discussion of hiring new policeman. Motion by Stan Thompson, second by Clarence Phillips to hire Matthew Hughes at non academy graduate pay. Vote was unanimous.
