A special meeting of the Mayor and Town Council was held November 8, 1972, with the following attending: Mayor H.R. Holliday, Councilmen George Fowler, Jack Kennemore, Furman Hopkins, Herbert Thompson, Jr., Glenn O'Dell.

Mayor Holliday presided over the meeting, and gave a report on the following projects:

- (a) 1973 Park Funding to be (\$5,000.00).
- (b) Low Rental Housing Project.
- (c) Park work & finances.
- (d) Brock Street repair work for next spring.
- (e) County work on streets and roads for this fall.

Mayor Holliday made a request that members of the Town Council help with certain projects. Councilman Cumbie be in charge of annexation. The Finance committee to help with certain financial reports, and the street committee to make a request of Duke Power Company to light the park.

A discussion was held on hiring a policeman to replace Harold McKern. Councilman Fowler made a motion that Lailon Cannon be hired to replace Mr. McKern. Councilman Hopkins seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.


Councilman O'Dell made a motion that the Street Committee have the authority to spend up to (\$300.00), on Christmas parade.
