A Special Call Meeting of the Town Council was held on Wednesday, December 16, 1970 at 6:00 P. M. at the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor, H. R. Holladay, Councilman J. R. Herd, George Fowler, Herbert Thompson, Jr., Glen D. O'Dell and Jack Kennemore.

The purpose of this Special Call Meeting was to bring before the Town Council the request from Mr. J. W. Wallace that his property described on said petition for annexation become a part of the Town Limits of the Town of Central, S. C. A Motion was made that this said property be annexed into the Town of Central. This motion was unanimously carried.

Police Chief, Harold Duncan was present for the meeting and made a recommendation to the Council to employ J. D. Corn on the Police Force. Mr. Corn was employed by a unanimous vote.


There was a request for ^{a creek line} water to be run across 18 Mile Creek for the residents in that area.
