THOSE PRESENT: Mayor Holladay, Councilmen Fowler, Hopkins, Kennemore, Busha, Porter, & Thompson.

Motion made by Fowler to purchase gas pump & tank that is located at the equipment lot from Exxon in the amt. of \$75.00 for pump, & \$60.00 for the tank, 2nd by Busha. Motion carried.

Mayor stated to the council that he had been in touch with the Town attorney concerning the zoning. Acker is to get a letter to the Town about the legal status of the zoned area.


\*\*Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Busha to give the regular Town Employee's a full weeks salary providing they had been with the Town a full year. Partical on the pro-rata bais. Motion Carried-

Motion made by Porter, 2nd by Busha, for the Town Employee's (St. Dept.) to be responsible for turning on the Christmas lights, Police to turn off between 11 & 12 o'clock with the exception of weekends and the Police would be responsibe for turning on and off. Motion Carried.

The Council voted to accept the Total Amt. Budget for 1974-75 with the exception of \$1,550.00 for the Fire Dept. not to buy the Alarm & the Mud Hog at the present. Five voted in favor of the exception, 1 against (Thompson). Motion Carried

Motion made by Kennemore, 2nd by Porter for All Town Employee's to have a purchase order before buying anything if the purchase is to exceed \$10.00 or more, also if something is bought here in Town a cash ticket must be signed by the individual purchasing the item. Due to the shortage of funds we must take these measures into consideration. Motion Carried.

Motion made by Porter, 2nd by Hopkins, that supplies be stored in the Old Jail or Depot such as water supplies etc. Lawn Mowers are to be removed form the Fire Dept. & stored. A want list will be keep inside the office for needed supplies so that the Committee can approve ahead of time for purchase. The buildings with supplies are to be locked at all times.
